Purpose

Appoint individuals to serve on the ad hoc Hillview Community Center Project Task Force

Background

On April 25, 2017, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2017-15 establishing the Hillview Community Center Project Task Force.

Discussion/Analysis

The Task Force will consist of 11 members and those appointed will serve until the completion of the work of the Task Force.

The City received 35 applications prior to the May 12, 2017 submission deadline. The Council interviewed applicants on May 16, 2017 and May 18, 2017.

Options

- 1) Appoint individuals to serve on the Hillview Community Center Project Task Force

Advantages: Forms the membership of the Task Force and will allow the body to begin meeting

Disadvantages: None identified

- 2) Do not appoint individuals to serve on the Hillview Community Center Project Task Force

Advantages: None identified

Disadvantages: Delays the formation of the Task Force

Recommendation
